

HOW TO VOTE

YOU MUST BE REGISTERED AT LEAST 29 DAYS BEFORE AN ELECTION TO BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE

EARLY VOTING

BY MAIL: REQUEST EARLY BALLOT

- *Online at www.recorder.pima.gov - request ballot be sent to you
- *By phone (520)740-4330 - request ballot be sent to you
When received, vote and mail in by deadline, or
- *You may drop your early ballot at any poll on election day

GO IN PERSON TO EARLY POLLING PLACES TO VOTE

- *Call (520)740-4330 and ask where early voting polls are located
- *Go online to www.recorder.pima.gov for information on location of early voting places

ON ELECTION DAY

HOW DO I FIND WHERE TO VOTE (MY POLLING PLACE)?

- *Look on the sample ballot that will be mailed to you
- *Go online www.recorder.pima.gov to polling/voter information
- *Call (520)740-4330 and ask where your poll is located

WHAT IDENTIFICATION (ID) DO I NEED?

One of the following IDs with photo, name and address

- *Valid Arizona drivers license or non-operating ID
- *Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal ID
- *Valid US, state or local government issued ID

OR

Two different IDs without photo, but with name and address

- *Utility bill (electric, gas, water, solid waste, sewer, phone, or cable TV bills that are dated within 90 days of election)

- *Bank or credit union statement
- *Valid AZ vehicle registration
- *Indian Census Card
- *Property tax statement of the voter's residence
- *Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal ID
- *Vehicle Insurance card

WHAT DO I DO AT THE POLLS TO VOTE?

- *Show your ID and sign the voter roster
- *You will be given a ballot
- *Vote by marking your ballot correctly
- *Take your ballot to the counting machine (opti-scan)

YOU CANNOT BE REFUSED A BALLOT: IF THERE IS A PROBLEM REQUEST A PROVISIONAL BALLOT
